Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 pm. The minutes of the October 2006 meetings of the THSPAB board and executive board were approved with the correct spelling of by-laws.

Treasurer's Report

Noreen Moucheron read the Treasurer's report and said the money from the Keys fundraiser has been designated for the marching band, minus \$500 that will go to the Show Choir. A motion was made by Damon Dye and seconded by Lorraine Ebbin to accept the Treasurer's report.

Marching Band Uniforms

The uniforms will eventually need to be replaced and the boosters may want to consider earmarking funds for the expenditure.

Cindy Kindl said she will contact Leslie Trego about having the marching band uniforms and choir robes cleaned.

Performing Arts Updates

"It's a Wonderful Life" opens November 16. THSPAB will run concessions, with funds going to the drama program.

The Show Choir fundraiser concert is scheduled for January 11. Cindy Kindl said she will check with Terry Moore to verify the amount of money from ticket sales and program ads that will be allocated to the Disney trip.

Lorraine Ebbin will ask Dorothy Baker if she would direct the performance at the proposed Mystery Theater/Spaghetti Dinner fundraiser. This event would potentially raise funds for scholarships, costumes, uniforms and other items needed by the performing arts programs.

Scholarship Committee

Cindy Kindl said she will ask Gerry Claiborne about the status of the scholarship committee.

Ways and Means

Lorraine Ebbin said the Gianni's fundraiser made close to \$1,000.

Lorraine Ebbin made a motion which was seconded by Noreen Moucheron to have 10% of the profits from fundraisers allocated to personal accounts.

Cindy Kindl said the boosters will do the Keys fundraiser for the whole 2007 season, which will include the Keys Café and up to five concerts. The boosters may get other groups such as chorus and drama to participate.

The boosters have an opportunity to run popcorn stands at five Ravens games next season.

A motion was passed to pay for flowers given to seniors at homecoming.

Marching Band Update

The successful marching band season will close with the ACC's in Scranton on November 11. Damon Dye said a number of issues need to be worked out for next year, including staff dissatisfaction, practice location and changes in the rehearsal schedule as a result of complaints. Damon said he will start working on these issues in January.

Cindy Kindl said she will write letters to Mr. Berno and the Frederick News Post to express support for the marching band program.

Lorraine Ebbin will look for a facility to hold the marching band banquet in early February.
